Francisco Lorenzo (Universidad Pablo de Olavide, de Sevilla)

European bilingual programs: learning outcomes, educational implications and social debates

The talk will present a summary of CLIL programs as they have been implemented in European countries over the last twenty years. We will consider how learning via an L2 affects content acquisition, L1 development and L2 consolidation. It will also reflect on the national (Spanish) and international debates caused by bilingual implementation (divides in school communities, resources, teacher training, etc...) and the subsequent social debates including media coverage of bilingual schools.
